(IMPOSITION OF A 20MPH AND 50MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202

THE LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL hereby gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under Sections 5, 81, 82(2), 83(2), 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, the effect of which will be:

To revoke a 50MPH speed limit in part on Lutterworth Road, Ullesthorpe

To impose a 20MPH speed limit on parts of the following roads:

Claybrooke Road, Frolesworth Road, Hall Lane, Mill Road, College Street, Fairway Meadows, The Leys, Main Street, Manor Road, Station Road, Stevens Close, The Dell, Green Gardens, South Avenue, Ashby Road, Sleath Drive, Lennard Close, Goodacre Road and Lutterworth Road, Ullesthorpe.

To impose a 50MPH speed limit on parts of the following roads:

Claybrooke Road, Ullesthorpe, Ullesthorpe Road, Claybrooke Parva, Main Road, Claybrooke Parva and Lutterworth Road, Ullesthorpe
